Encore "A Night at the Oscars"

Our Annual Production is tentatively set for Saturday June 8th, pending venue approval. We will send an Annual Production Guidelines packet some time in April. This will have very detailed information about the show so it is important to read through it thoroughly.

All classes are now working on recital choreography. Attendance is important to keep the class flow moving with recital choreography. If your dancer misses please plan accordingly to ensure your dancer learns any choreography they missed before their next class.

Photoshoot is scheduled for Monday June 3rd and Tuesday June 4th in the afternoon/evening. All classes will have their recital photos taken this day. More information will be made available in the Annual Production Guidelines
